DESIGN TREND IDENTIFICATION

Trend Distribution:

1. Minimalist Contemporary: 32%

- Brightness (lumens) should match room function
- Positioning: Task lighting + ambient lighting balance

5. Statement Pieces

- 1 designer/luxury lamp per room recommended
- Creates focal point, elevates entire space

Emerging Trends (2026-2027):

- Sustainable artisan lamps: +35% growth projected
- Smart/tech-enabled lamps: +42% adoption
- Mixed metal finishes: +28% popularity
- Customizable modular lamps: +25% interest
